GARBAGE AND RECYCLING



Pick-up day is Friday.
Have items on the curb by 7:00 a.m.

The City of St. Clair contracts with Waste Management for garbage and recycling services. Use the green bin for recyclables. Garbage can be placed in your own garbage can, in garbage bags or in a Waste Management garbage cart. If you need a garbage cart or recycling bin please contact the City Clerk at 507-245-3494.

Garbage Limit: 1–60-gallon cart or 2–30 gallon garbage bags weekly. Additional garbage must be tagged. Tags are available at City Hall for \$2.00 per tag.

Acceptable recyclables include: glass, aluminum, tin cans, plastic containers, mixed paper and corrugated cardboard.

If you need to dispose of a large item contact Waste Management at 507-388-1157 to make arrangements for a special pick up.



UNLICENSED, INOPERABLE VEHICLES

All vehicles must have current tabs and must be in working order. Vehicles not licensed and not in working order must be stored in a garage or removed from the property.




2012 ELECTION

ELECTION JUDGES NEEDED!



Election Judges are needed for the
August 14th Primary Election and the
November 6th General Election.

St. Clair Election Judges are appointed by the City Council and trained by the Blue Earth County Elections Dept. Election Day is divided into two shifts: 6:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.; and 1:30 p.m. to (approx.) 8:30 p.m. St. Clair Election Judges receive \$8.50 per hour.

To be an Election Judge:

- You must be eligible to vote in Minnesota.
- You must be able to read, write and speak English.
- You cannot be a spouse, parent, child or sibling of any Election Judge in the same precinct.
- You cannot be a candidate or the spouse, parent, child or sibling of any candidate on the ballot in that precinct.
