NOTICE OF FILING AFFIDAVITS OF CANDIDACY
FOR CITY ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Minnesota Statute 204B.33 a General Election will be held in the City of St. Clair on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following City offices:

MAYOR (1 position - 2 year term)
CITY COUNCIL (2 positions - 4 year term)

The period for filing Affidavits of Candidacy for these offices BEGINS on Tuesday, July 31st and ENDS at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 14th

Affidavits of Candidacy are filed with the City Clerk at the St. Clair City Hall, 304 Main Street West, St. Clair, Minnesota.

At the time of filing, each candidate shall pay the filing fee of two dollars (\$2.00).

A candidate for City Office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or more upon assuming office, must be a resident of St. Clair at least 30 days before Election Day (November 6th), and must have no other Affidavit of Candidacy on file for any other office in the General Election.

2012 ELECTION DATES

PRIMARY ELECTION: Tuesday, August 14th
GENERAL ELECTION: Tuesday, November 6th

Polls are open from 7 am to 8 pm on Election Day.
The polling place for St. Clair residents is the St. Clair City Hall, 304 Main Street West, St. Clair.



GRASS CLIPPINGS

Please mow your lawn away from the street so your grass clippings do not end up in the City storm sewer. The storm sewers are not designed to handle quantities of leaves and grass clippings. During a rainstorm, grass clippings, leaves and other yard debris can quickly plug storm drains and pipes and cause back-ups and other problems.

DROP OFF SITE FOR EXPIRED and UNUSED MEDICATIONS

The Blue Earth County Environmental Services Dept., the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Dept., Xcel Energy and Mayo Clinic Health System have partnered to bring a Medication Collection Program to Blue Earth County residents.

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Monday-Friday)

For disposal through the Blue Earth County Medication Collection Program, medications do not need to be in the original container. Remove as much packaging as possible. Containers with liquid contents should be placed in a plastic bag.

Medications dropped-off at the collection site are taken directly to an incinerator, where a deputy watches their destruction.
