

TREE TRIMMING

Residents with trees overhanging public sidewalks and streets are asked to trim their trees in accordance with the City Ordinance Code. Trees should be trimmed and maintained at a distance of 8' above sidewalks and 12' above streets. This distance allows for safe pedestrian travel on sidewalks and adequate clearance for fire and emergency vehicles on our streets.

NOTICE OF FILING AFFIDAVITS OF CANDIDACY
FOR CITY ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Minnesota Statute 204B.33 a General Election will be held in the City of St. Clair on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following City offices:

MAYOR	(1 position - 2 year term)
CITY COUNCIL	(2 positions - 4 year term)

The period for filing Affidavits of Candidacy for these offices BEGINS on Tuesday, July 31st and ENDS at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 14th

Affidavits of Candidacy are filed with the City Clerk at the St. Clair City Hall, 304 Main Street West, St. Clair, Minnesota.

At the time of filing, each candidate shall pay the filing fee of two dollars (\$2.00).

A candidate for City Office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or more upon assuming office, must be a resident of St. Clair at least 30 days before Election Day (November 6th), and must have no other Affidavit of Candidacy on file for any other office in the General Election.

2012 ELECTION DATES

PRIMARY ELECTION: Tuesday, August 14th
GENERAL ELECTION: Tuesday, November 6th

Polls are open from 7 am to 8 pm. The polling place for St. Clair residents is the St. Clair City Hall.



RV, BOAT, TRAILER, ETC. ... PARKING REGULATIONS

No recreational vehicle (including ... motor home, utility trailer, travel trailer, truck camper, boat, snowmobile, camping trailer, racing trailer, personal watercraft, four-wheeler, or other such item used primarily for recreational purposes or the trailer on which such vehicle is hauled) shall be parked or stored on any street, alley, dead-end or public right-of-way in the City of St. Clair, except for the express purpose of loading/ unloading.
