# Proclamation

**WHEREAS:** The United States of America was founded upon the premise that all citizens should enjoy the blessings of freedom and liberty; and

**WHEREAS:** The freedom and liberty that Americans enjoy, and which are longed for by people the world over, are the direct result of the many sacrifices made by America's veterans in securing these blessings; and

**WHEREAS:** Many Minnesotans have made the supreme sacrifice in defense of the cause of freedom; and

**WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper that we recognize the courageous efforts of our veterans who have sacrificed so much of themselves to secure freedom and liberty for all Americans; and

**WHEREAS:** The American Legion Auxiliary, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary have adopted the poppy as their commemorative symbol; and

**WHEREAS:** Each year, disabled veterans assemble and distribute memorial poppies, thereby creating a tangible tribute that honors our nation's fallen heroes and benefits living veterans and their families.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Douglas Westphal, Mayor of the City of St. Clair, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2013 as:

## POPPY MONTH

in the City of St. Clair and encourage all citizens to recognize the poppy as a symbol designated to honor the brave individuals who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the name of freedom.
