RV, BOAT and TRAILER PARKING REGULATIONS



No recreational vehicle or trailer (including ... motor home, utility trailer, travel trailer, truck camper, boat, snowmobile trailer, camping trailer, racing trailer, personal watercraft, four-wheeler, or other such item used primarily for recreational purposes or the trailer on which such vehicle is hauled) shall be parked or stored on any street, alley, dead-end, or public right-of-way in the City of St. Clair, except for the express purpose of loading/ unloading.

Garden Meter



Residents may purchase a second water meter from the City for outside water use. Sewer fees will not be charged on the water used through the garden meter. Contact the City Clerk at 245-3494 for more information or to obtain a garden meter. PLEASE NOTE: The City does not install the garden meter. Meters should be installed by a licensed plumber.



Grass Clippings

Please mow your lawn away from the street so your grass clippings do not end up in the City storm sewer. The storm sewers are not designed to handle quantities of leaves and grass clippings. During a rainstorm, grass clippings and other yard debris can quickly plug storm drains and pipes.

Building Permits



A Building and/or Zoning Permit is required for almost all building or construction projects in the City. Contact the City Clerk (245-3494) for a Building Permit Application or for additional information before undertaking any building project.
