## SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL

Reminder to property owners/occupants adjacent to public sidewalks are responsible for ice and/or snow removal from public sidewalks within 36 hours after the ice/snow ceases to fall. If the sidewalk is not cleared within the designated time the city will hire it done at a charge to the property owner of \$50.00 per time. Any costs not paid will be certified to Blue Earth County for collection with property taxes.

## Move Your Vehicle ... or get towed!



Use off-street parking after any snowfall of 1" or more until the street has been plowed curb to curb.

If snowplows are forced to go around parked vehicles, the snow surrounding the car can create a hazard to the traveling public as well as plow operators and equipment.

Vehicles that have been parked on the street longer than twenty-four (24) hours after a snowfall event and have prohibited the complete clearing of the street are subject to towing and impounding at the owners expense.



## CAT OWNERS

A number of cats are roaming around town especially in the downtown area. Pet owners are asked to be respectful of their neighbors and follow the City Pet Ordinance, which includes dogs and CATS. DO NOT allow your dog or CAT roam and wander ... keep your pet at home.



## HOLIDAY GARBAGE & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

There will be a one (1) day delay in garbage and recycling pick-up services during the week of the following holidays:

- Thanksgiving – pick-up will be Saturday, Nov. 28<sup>th</sup>
- Christmas – pick-up will be Saturday, Dec. 26<sup>th</sup>
- New Year's – pick-up will be Saturday, Jan. 2<sup>nd</sup>
